The theme of 'drawing' motion – through 'stillness' (or: as sequences of 'stills'?) is potentially interesting, pedagogically and academically.

However, the abstract's 'poetic' qualities ("the lens of analysis, distillation and discourse" etc.) make it difficult to assess the true potentials of the proposed paper, as interesting as the as the matter would appear to be in the context of the DCA.
